All Centres are required to change their Centre uniform to incorporate the LAVic logo on the upper right side prior to the 2013/14 season.

Knox will be introducing it for the 2012/13 season.

The Knox Centre Executive thought this would be a good opportunity to change the design of the Knox uniform but still retain the Centre's traditional colours of predominately yellow and black.

The latest sublimation print technology allows any type of artwork or pattern to be reproduced without relying on the set cut material patterns from the past.

Who better to come up with a new design than our athletes themselves?

As such, we are running a competition to design the new Centre uniform.

You may use the template on the following pages to assist for colouring in. Artwork must be original and not copied from another design.
